### **Recommendations:**

Use only non-stretch fastening ropes or straps. Do not overload your Rhino-Rack Alloy Tray and roof bars. Check your vehicle's roof carrying capacity. Exercise caution when driving offroad as vehicle roof height has been increased.

### Load Rating:

To be used with 4.0kg gas cylinders. Do not use on cylinders greater than 4.0kg.

#### Caution:

The handling characteristics of the vehicle change when you transport a load on the roof. For safety reasons, we recommend exercising extreme care when transporting large wind-resisting loads; special consideration must be taken into account when negotiating corners and under braking.

Do not transport gas in an unapproved cylinder. Gas bottles must be stored in an upright position. Do not transport with regulators attached. Must not be used for lifting. Always inspect prior to use. Protect from friction and abrasion. Do not tie knots in webbing. Do not use strap if it is damaged.

It is important that all roof racks and accessories are installed and attached correctly. Failure to follow the correct attachments could result in an accident, serious injury or death to others. The driver of the vehicle is responsible for securing the roof racks and accessories, checking the attachments, periodically checking bolt torque and visual inspection of all components for wear and damage. Do not attempt to fit the roof rack system or accessory to your vehicle unless you fully understand these fitting instructions.
